Performing Arts Concert

On Wednesday 19th July, before the conclusion of last term, we enjoyed the first Performing Arts Concert at Bosvigo. It was proudly presented by the pupils of Ms Oram celebrating both successes and progress. The pupils performed to a full school hall, complete with staging, lighting and a back-drop in front of family, peers and unfamiliar faces!

For several children this was a debut performance, from Year 1 through to Year 6, we heard and enjoyed a variety of songs. Great courage was shown by all pupils who got up and sang on stage, they showed true grit and determination overcoming their nerves and allowing us all to have the honour of sharing their musical performances. Bosvigo pupils were also joined by some of Ms Oram's private Singing & Piano pupils from outside of school, one of whom being a former Bosvigo pupil returning many years after moving on to Penair. We were delighted to hear Rose Penrose sing two of her Grade 1 exam pieces, Rose achieved a Pass with Merit in her examination which is an excellent achievement anyway, however after only 4 months of lessons it is outstanding. We also heard super performances by Maia Lister, Angus Banks, Molly Harvey, Arthur Coutts, Olivia Oram, Izzie Berry and Mattie Roach.

The second half of the concert was performed by the newly formed Drama Group. The small cast delivered a playlet called, "A History of Messy Rooms" by Wade Bradford. The concert fell exactly 7 weeks after the Drama Group first came together to work, so it was a great achievement for them to perform with such confidence and poise after so little time. Izzie Berry & Maia Lister took the roles of Jamie & Mum, while the rest of the cast each performed multiple roles, with Aoife Slade tying the piece together as Narrator. Cast members were India Freeman-Salter, Mattie Roach, Olivia Oram, Amelia Santolamazza & Arthur Coutts.

All the pupils and parents were buzzing following the concert and are all excited to begin the new academic year looking forward to the next chapter in our Performing Arts work. This term the Drama Group will be performing "Spooky Spectacular" and several singers will be working towards Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music Examinations, plus a Spring concert looking ahead.

We have big Musical Theatre style plans in Drama Group too this year... so watch this space!
