British Values 2017

On Tuesday 10th, Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th October all children in Bosvigo have been invited to the Baptist Church for a newly updated interactive event based on British Values. This will address our Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural curriculum through Reflective Spaces.

The four British Values are:

Democracy: making decisions together

Rule of law: understanding rules matter

Individual liberty: enjoying freedom for all

Mutual respect and tolerance: treating others as we want to be treated

At Bosvigo School we challenge stereotyping and behaviours that do not reflect these four values. We also actively promote tolerance of other faiths, cultures and races and help our children become confident, responsible members of their community.

The experience will give the children opportunities to ask questions, respect other people's opinions and think about their own behaviour, considering positive changes.

If family members are interested, the British Values Reflective Spaces will be open to visitors after school on Tuesday 10th October from 3.15 - 4.15 pm.

This week's assembly was an invitation to the whole school to say a huge thank you to the Royal National Lifeboat Institution.

During the summer holidays, many of us have enjoyed playing on the beach, swimming and surfing in the sea. The RNLI lifeguards help to keep us safe: preventing accidents and rescuing us when we're in trouble. Incredibly they are volunteers - meaning that they don't get paid to risk their lives saving others!

We welcomed Mr Peter Greenslade who has been connected with the RNLI for 41 years. He was responsible for getting the crew to the boat house and making sure everyone knew what to do.

Falmouth lifeboat station has been saving lives for 150 years. It is now trying to raise £100,000 to create a new, larger station so that the next faster, bigger lifeboat can be looked after.

Each phase team has now been given the challenge to see how much money they can raise before Thursday 19th October.
