Race for the Line Rocket Car Challenge

On Monday Bosvigo made its first appearance in the Race for the Line rocket car challenge. Teams of up to four children from Years 5 and 6 were given a block of foam, four wheels and two axles and were encouraged to turn this into the fastest car possible. Having shaped and smoothed our foam blocks, our teams made the short journey to Truro High School where, under the close supervision and direction of the Army, they added rocket packs and tested their cars for speed and acceleration.

Healthy Relationships Workshops for Key Stage 1

After Easter we will be involved in a healthy relationships pilot project. This will involve all children in Years 1 and 2 taking part in three 40-minute workshops led by professionals from CLEAR, an organisation that supports children in Cornwall who have experienced or are part of a family who has experienced abuse. The content of the workshops has been designed for 5-7 year-olds and will help children further their understanding of what it means to have healthy relationships (friendships) with one another. The workshops will also look at e-safety and online activity at an age-appropriate level.

Prior to the workshops taking place, we have arranged an opportunity for parents to meet the professionals leading the workshops and ask any questions they might have. This informal session will take place on Thursday 20th April at 2:40pm in Class 9. If you have any questions in the meantime, please feel free to ask Mr Wallis.

Over the past two weeks, we have been delighted to welcome Cornwall Fire and Rescue Service, Princes Trust: Team 11 to Bosvigo School.

The Princes Trust run a programme for 16 – 25 year olds not in employment, education or training. The programme is 12 weeks long and covers teamwork, work experience, career planning, event management, presentation skills, a residential and a community project.

Bosvigo was selected as one of five community projects for consideration, Team 11 narrowed the options to three, visited each project and completed a “pro’s and con’s” session for those three to finalise their decision. The team then had only 10 days to complete the project!



The team had to plan and resource their project. They worked with Mrs Austin from Bosvigo’s Wraparound to complete the garden design and completed a sponsored walk from Wadebridge to Padstow and back to raise funds for equipment.
